## Information on personal data treatment

In case of participation to convivial-social events, in the registration form information related to particular data categories (ex. food intolerance) may be included.: these data will be treated according to privacy needs as set by current laws.

The filling out of online forms or possible explicit and voluntary sending of messages via email to the reported email addresses of this website imply the subsequent acquisition of the email address of the sender, necessary to respond to the query, as well as other possible personal data included in the message or in the filled form. We invite users not to include sensible data within their emails (such as sensible or legal data).

More specifically, the data provided by the user at the moment of registration and participation to the conference “Immunotherapy for Infectious Diseases 2020” will be treated for the following purposes:

- Management of registrations, including attendance registration in some cases, as well as issuing participation certificates
- Communications related to this event
- Sharing of name, surname, email address among the registered users
- Sharing of contributions among participants via forum/activities available on the online platform (interactions between tutors and students)
- Management and technical maintenance of the website .....insert website’s link when available

Treatment of personal data may also concern historical, statistical or scientific aims, by abiding to current laws and deontological codes.

Providing personal data is generally mandatory to be able to register and then participate to the activities related to the conference “Immunotherapy for Infectious Diseases 2020”. Refusal to provide personal data implies the impossibility to register and participate to the above-mentioned conference.
